

When Will This Be Done?

Phase I is scheduled April - August 2023

Phase II is scheduled August - October 2023

Phase III is scheduled November 2023

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Two lanes will be open in each direction, weekdays from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. throughout the project limits, with the exception of Remick Drive to Wellington Crescent and occasional nights and weekends where traffic will be reduced to one lane.

On NB M-3 from Remick Dr to Wellington Crescent, intermittent night time full closures may be required and a detour will be posted.

Work will occur day and night. Business and pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the project.

Long-term Benefits

The project will extend the life of the roadway and allow for better traffic flow along M-3 through Clinton Township and the surrounding municipalities.



What is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be resurfacing 3.3 Miles of M-3 (Gratiot Avenue) in Clinton Township. The project will be completed in three phases:

Phase I

14 Mile Road to Wellington Crescent Right Two Lanes (NB and SB)

Resurface:

Asphalt Roadway

Replace:

- Intermittent Curb and Gutter Replacements
- Signs
- · Install modern signals
- Improve ramps and sidewalks to be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Begin reconstruction of median turnaround on NB M-3 at Remick

Phase II

14 Mile Road to Wellington Crescent Left Two Lanes (NB and SB)

- · Same as Phase I
- Complete reconstruction of median turnaround on NB M-3 at Remick

Phase III

All Lanes

Place top layer of asphalt roadway
