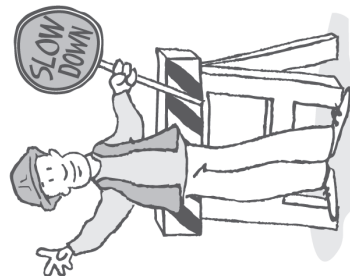

What is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be rebuilding 3.4 miles of M-3 (Gratiot Avenue) in the city of Roseville. The project will be completed in two phases:

Phase I

11 Mile Road to Common Road

- Replace:
 - Asphalt roadway
 - Water mains
 - Storm sewers
 - Signs
- Install modern signals
- Improvements:
 - Ramps and sidewalks to be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
 - Intersection alignment at Utica Road
- Add plants, trees and shrubs

Phase II

Common Road to 14 Mile Road

- Same as Phase I
- Intersection improvements at the I-94/M-3 connector

When Will This Be Done?

Phase I is scheduled March - November 2021.

Phase II is scheduled March - November 2022.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Two lanes will be open in each direction through the project area 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Traffic may be reduced to one lane in each direction during off-peak hours depending on construction operations.

Work will occur day and night. Business and pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the project.

Long-term Benefits

The project will extend the life of the roadway and allow for better traffic flow along M-3 through the city of Roseville and surrounding municipalities.
