M-3 (Gratiot Avenue) project update: Eastbound Common Road access to northbound M-3 closed for two weeks for intersection rebuilding in city of Roseville

PROJECT DETAILS:

As part of the project to rebuild M-3, eastbound Common Road needs to be closed at M-3 to allow crews to rebuild the median of the intersection between northbound and southbound M-3. Weather permitting, [eastbound Common Road access to northbound M-3 will be closed](#) from 6 a.m. Monday, Oct. 11, to 6 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 23. Median sidewalks will also be closed. Eastbound Common Road traffic will still be able to access southbound M-3.

Eastbound Common Road traffic heading for northbound M-3 will be directed to southbound M-3, then to the next available crossover to turn onto northbound M-3. Southbound M-3 traffic can access westbound Common Road. Pedestrians will be detoured to the median crosswalk at Bigelow Street.
